## MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION

## June 9, 2010

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chairman Joe Morgan. Staff present were Executive Director Greg Kirkpatrick, License Supervisor Vicki Wright, Fiscal Manager Jennifer Padgett, Investigators Otis Hogan and Danny Holmes, and Legal Counsel Arnold Jochums. All Commissioners were present with the exception of Commissioner Wallace and Futrell. Visitor's present were legal counsel James Hensley representing Nathan Pruss dba-Bruno's ATV & Powersports and Four Seasons Motor Sports. Hearing Officer Kendra Akin-Jones and Court Reporter Susan Whitson were also in attendance.

The minutes from April 21, 2010, were reviewed and approved as written.

The Commission held H#10-002 AMVC vs. Nathan Pruss dba Bruno's ATV and Powersports and Four Seasons Motor Sports. After hearing testimony from Commission Investigators and reviewing evidence presented in the case, the Commission found Nathan Pruss violated Commission statutes by displaying and offering for sale new motor vehicles without a license as well as, acting as a distributor of new motor vehicles without a license. The Commission agreed on a monetary fine of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), due within thirty (30) days upon receipt of the order.

Director Kirkpatrick updated the Commission members on the status of the arbitration hearings being held between General Motors, Chrysler and Arkansas dealers.

Director Kirkpatrick informed the Commission members of Ford's announcement that it will be discontinuing the Mercury line and how it will affect Arkansas dealers.

The meeting was then adjourned by Chairman Morgan.
