

MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEIDCLE COMMISSION

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chairman Sandy Stroope. Staff present included Greg Kirkpatrick, Gordon McCoy, and Crystal Campbell. All Commissioners were present during the meeting with the exception of Kenneth Burks and Ford Trotter who missed with excused absences. Also in attendance were the court reporter Susan Whitson, and Julie Chavis with the Attorney General's Office.

The minutes from the October 21, 2015, and November 3, 2015, meetings were unanimously approved following a proper motion and second.

The Commission unanimously approved the meeting expenditures for the December 16, 2015, meeting following a proper motion and second.

The Commission unanimously approved the fiscal reports for October and November 2015 following a proper motion and second.

The Commission approved the Ad Hoc committee recommendations as presented. Specifically, the Commission approved the issuance of a five hundred dollar (\$500.00) fine against a dealership due to an unreasonable delay in providing the vehicle title as per Ark. Code Ann. § 23-112-308(a)(26).


The Commission then moved to the Public Hearing for Rule 10 on the Education and Training Grant Program presented by Greg Kirkpatrick and Crystal Campbell. No public comments were offered regarding the proposed Rule 10.

The Commission then considered the request by Cub Cadet under Ark. Code Ann. § 23-112-403(a)(2)(C)(ii) to declare an existing dealer abandoned the franchise or selling agreement to provide for good cause to waive the sixty (60) day notice requirement and allow for an immediate termination. The Commission determined the dealer did not abandon the franchise or selling agreement under this provision of statute.

Greg Kirkpatrick presented Commission and Board Member Handbooks and discussed highlights including general expectations of members, conflicts of interest, and liability issues.

Chairman Stroope accepted a proper motion and a second to adjourn the meeting.
