**WAGNER'S CYCLE SHOP**

**FINDINGS OF FACTS, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER**

On January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2005, the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission (hereinafter "Commission") held a hearing in the above-styled matter. Wagner's Cycle Shop, the Respondent, violated the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Law and Rules promulgated therein.

Mr. Michael Wagner and Ms. Felicia Landes appeared on behalf of the Respondent. Assistant Attorney General Arnold M. Jochums appeared on behalf of the Commissions staff.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

That in early November 2004 Mr. Michael Wagner advertised and offered to the public for sale and was selling motor vehicles produced by Irbit Motorworks of America, at a time when it was not licensed to sell motor vehicles in the State of Arkansas.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact the Commission concludes that Wagner's Cycle Shop has violated A.C.A. §23-112-301(a)(1)(2)(d)(A)(B).

The Commission determines that the appropriate disposition in this case is the imposition of a civil penalty of \$500.00 and that the dealer must become properly licensed to do business in the State of Arkansas as a new motor vehicle dealer.
